Zbigniew Seifert Jazz Violin Competition

The International Zbigniew Seifert Jazz Violin Competition took place

between 16th and 19th July 2014 in Cracow. It was the first time that this

unique event has been organized.

The idea of the International Jazz Violin Competition emerged from a need to commemorate the great violinist and to highlight the role which Zbigniew Seifert played as an eminent jazz musician. To this day he has numerous followers worldwide, fascinated with the violin style he created.

Cracow – Seifert's home town as well as a cradle of Polish jazz – is a perfect place to promote jazz and violinist's heritage on the world scale.

The aim of the Competition was to determine musical individuals of Zbigniew Seifert stature. 63 musicians applied from 17 coutries! The event has ended international success. the competition was selected to the prestigious award Koryfeusz Muzyki Polskiej www.koryfeusz.org.pl.

Our database is Poland's only large-scale online jazz archive!!!!




Rafal Olbinski Jazz on the Cover 2014

February 8-23, 2014 - Lotos Jazz Festival – Bielska Zadymka Jazzowa (Zbigniew Seifert Foundation was a co-organiser of the exhibition entitled "FROM JAZZ TO OPERA". Except great Jazz Forum covers the audience could admire outstanding opera posters.

The exhibition was shown in SFERA GALLERY http://www.sfera.com.pl/, Mostowa str. 5, Bielsko-Biała February 22, 2014 at 5.30 PM – there was the closing of the exhibition with the participation of Rafał Olbiński. Music – Leszek HeFi Wiśniowski solo flute. March 3 - 20, 2014 - Izmir Jazz Festival exhibition was a part of the 600th anniversary of Polish-Turkish diplomatic relations. Except "Jazz on the Cover" exhibition was a workshop leaded by Rafał Olbiński and a lecture of Paweł Brodowski - Jazz Forum editor-in-chief entitled "50 years with Jazz Forum – then and now".
